THE PRE-LENTEN SEASON BEGINS TODAY with the Sunday of the Pharisee and the Publican. We open the Church's Lenten prayer book, the Triodion, for the first time to sing the kondak of the Pharisee and the Publican. This Friday is a free Friday (*vol'nica*): there is no fasting or abstinence from meat this week. At Vespers, the Church prays: "O faithful, let us not pray like the Pharisee, for those who exalt themselves shall be humbled. Let us humble ourselves before God, and with the publican, let us say: 'Lord have mercy on me, a sinner.'"

Beginning today, consider making the following tropars part of your daily prayer until Pascha:

Open to me the gates of repentance, O Giver of life, for my soul rises early toward your holy Temple, burdened with the temple of my body all defiled. But purify me by your tender mercy, O Compassionate One.

Lead me on the paths of salvation, O Theotokos, for I have condemned myself with shameful sins and have wasted my life in slothfulness. By your intercession, save me from all sinfulness.

When I think upon the multitude of my evil deeds, I tremble for the fearsome day of judgment. But trusting in the compassion of your mercy, O Lord, like David I cry out to you: Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your great mercy.

Beginning next Sunday, we will add Psalm 136, "By the waters of Babylon" before the Divine Liturgy for the rest of the Pre-Lenten period. This Psalm, with its beautiful Ruthenian chant melody, expresses how sin exiles us from God and our longing to return to Him. Please pick up a copy of the text next Sunday and sing along.
