YOUR SACRIFICIAL OFFERINGS FOR MARCH 1: \$3226.00. Your parish relies on your regular attendance and consistent sacrificial offerings. **IT TAKES \$7000.00 each week** to operate *St Michael's Cathedral, Chapel, and Rectory* and to provide ordinary services to parishioners. Factoring in the income from the school lease we still need \$3750 in offerings each week. **This week we fell short by \$524.00.** Our Lord challenges us to sacrifice from our substance, not skim off our surplus. ST MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL FOOD PANTRY NEEDS YOUR SUPPORT every time you come to worship. Lately we are short on canned meat, dry beans, and cereals (including oatmeal). We are overstocked on rice, ramen and pasta. **THE GOAL: Every parishioner brings one item every Sunday.** Thank you to everyone who has responded!

THE SACRAMENT OF REPENTANCE: Please note special hours for confessions at the Cathedral. Confessions are always heard every Sunday from 8:15 to 8:45am at the Cathedral and from 10:30am to 10:45am at the Chapel, and one half hour before the Liturgy of the Presanctified in both locations. The law of the Church requires all Catholics to confess their sins at least once a year and receive Holy Communion at least once during Pascha.

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who approach Holy Communion are obliged to abstain from meat products on all Wednesdays and Fridays of the Great Fast; and to fast (reduced quantity of food) and to abstain from all meat, dairy and egg products on Clean Monday (February 24) and Great and Holy Friday (April 10). The traditional Byzantine fast prescribes abstinence from all animal products, wine, and olive oil for the duration of the Fast, with relaxations for wine, oil and fish on certain feast days and Sundays. All the faithful are encouraged to find a reasonably challenging fasting plan somewhere between the legal minimums and the full traditional observance.
