Set aside some time each week to work through your child's ECF text, the lives of the saints, or one of our parish's home school texts. Call or email the Office for more recommendations of available books for study with children. ECF classes via Zoom are going very well. Parents will be contacted with invitation before each Sunday session at 11am.
