OPEN AIR "PARKING LOT" LITURGY AT THE CHAPEL 11AM! In compliance with the Governor's Directives of May 13, 2020, we are now permitted to serve the Liturgy with a live congregation in our parking lot. The following rules must be STRICTLY observed.

1. Cars must be parked **6 feet apart**. There must be **one empty parking space** between each car.
2. You must **remain in your cars** for the duration of the Liturgy.
3. The Chapel building will not be open and **bathrooms will not be accessible**. No exceptions.
4. **Holy Communion cannot be distributed at the Liturgy. We are under a "no contact" rule. No exceptions.**
5. Please make your regular sacrificial offering online or by mail. **No collection will be taken at this Liturgy.**
6. Donations for the food pantry may be left by Fr. Jack's car, which will be marked.
7. No one who is at elevated risk or feeling unwell should attend. No one who cannot comply with these guidelines should attend. Worship via our live-stream Liturgy at 9am instead.
8. **Confessions cannot be heard before or after this Liturgy. Please call the Office and make an appointment for individual confession and/or Holy Communion.**
