THE CHAPEL WILL NOT OPEN FOR INDOOR LITURGY WITHOUT THE SERVICE OF TRAINED USHERS:

Any man or woman 18 or older who is willing to arrive early, learn and enforce safety protocols, and welcome guests. **Please contact Fr. Jack immediately if you are willing to help reopen the Chapel.**

OUR FOOD PANTRY IS OPEN AND SERVING OUR NEIGHBORS THANKS TO YOU! We always need 1-2lb bags of rice, bags of beans, canned fruit and vegetables, canned meat, tuna, spaghetti, cereals, mac and cheese, and Chef Boyardee. **We are overstocked on ramen noodles and peanut butter & jelly.**

COVID-19 MEASURES: IN GENERAL: No one at elevated risk or feeling unwell should attend. No one who cannot comply with these guidelines should attend. Worship via our live-stream Liturgy at 9am.

Father is masked to distribute Holy Communion or to hear confessions, limits contact with anything the faithful might touch during the Liturgy, sanitizes before touching the Holy Gifts, and does not drink from the Chalice. The Cathedral is completely disinfected each week before Sunday Divine Liturgy.

AT ST MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL: PLEASE NOTE:

1. Wear a mask when in the building. Hand sanitizer, masks, and gloves are available for your use.
2. Keep 6 feet social distance by using only the marked spaces at open pews. Persons who live together may sit together.
3. Place your sacrificial offering in the basket in the center aisle. Ushers will not take up a collection.
4. Approach for Holy Communion in a SINGLE LINE and follow marks on floor to maintain social distance.
5. Exit the Church in an orderly manner, maintaining 6 feet distance. Do not congregate in the Vestibule.
6. Take a green Liturgy book for your personal use. Take it home with you and bring it with you whenever you come to worship. Books may not be left in Church for random use.
7. Confessions are heard at the Iconostasis. Approach the altar rail to indicate your desire to confess.
8. Leave donations for the Food Pantry in the Vestibule.

OPEN AIR LITURGY AT THE CHAPEL: PLEASE NOTE:

1. Cars must be parked 6 feet apart. There must be one empty parking space between each car.
2. You must remain in your cars for the duration of the Liturgy.
3. The Chapel building will not be open and bathrooms will not be accessible. No exceptions.
4. Holy Communion will be distributed via single-use spoons in a "drive by" following the Liturgy. Please follow directions and maintain a respectful silence during the reception of Holy Communion.
5. You may drop your offering in the box as you enter the lot. **No one can accept donations by hand!**
6. Donations for the food pantry may be left by Fr. Jack's car, near the Holy Communion station.
7. Confessions cannot be heard before or after this Liturgy. Please call the Office and make an appointment for individual confession.
