OUR FOOD PANTRY IS OPEN AND SERVING OUR NEIGHBORS THANKS TO YOU! We always need 1-2lb bags of rice or beans, peanut butter, grape jelly, canned fruit, vegetables, meat, tuna, and soups; spaghetti, cereals, mac and cheese.

COVID-19 MEASURES: IN GENERAL: **No one at elevated risk or feeling unwell should attend. No one who cannot comply with these guidelines should attend. Worship via our live-stream Liturgy at 9am.**

Father is masked to distribute Holy Communion or to hear confessions, limits contact with anything the faithful might touch during the Liturgy, sanitizes before touching the Holy Gifts, and does not drink from the Chalice. The Cathedral and Chapel are completely disinfected each week before Sunday Divine Liturgy.

AT ST MICHAEL'S CATHEDRAL: PLEASE NOTE:

1. Wear a mask when in the building. Hand sanitizer and masks are available for your use.
2. Keep 6 feet distance by using only the marked spaces at open pews. Those who live together may sit together.
3. Place your sacrificial offering in the basket in the center aisle. Ushers will not take up a collection.
4. Approach for Holy Communion in a SINGLE LINE and follow marks on floor to maintain social distance.
5. Exit the Church in an orderly manner, maintaining 6 feet distance. Do not congregate in the Vestibule.
6. Take a green Liturgy book home and bring it with you whenever worship. Books may not be left in Church.
7. Confessions are heard at the Iconostasis. Approach the altar rail to indicate your desire to confess.
8. Leave donations for the Food Pantry in the Vestibule.

AT ST MICHAEL'S CHAPEL: PLEASE NOTE:

1. Everyone attending the Liturgy must wear a **mask**. Masks and sanitizers are available in the vestibule.
2. We are limited to **50 places, which are clearly marked with blue tape**. The large pews in the rear are limited to **4 persons each**, and there are only **5 places available in the vestibule**. Persons who live together may sit together. Your usual spot may not be available and the front pews must be occupied by someone to make room for everyone. **Please follow the guidance of ushers and be considerate of others.**
3. For **Holy Communion**: please form a single line, keeping distance as marked on the floor. Please return via the side aisles only.
4. Please take a **Liturgy Book** for your personal use if you wish. Take it home and bring it back with you each week. It is yours to keep forever. Do not leave it, or anything else, in the pews.
5. **Interior doors, including bathroom doors, must remain open** to limit contact. Your privacy is not affected. **One person permitted in each bathroom** at a time. Please use the sanitizers provided to wipe down handles and faucets after you use them. **Children under 12 must be supervised in the bathroom by a parent.**
6. **The social hall, the lower hall, and the elevator are all closed.**

Anyone who is unwilling or unable to follow these guidelines for social distancing, limited contact and disinfectant should continue to worship via the live stream. Your patient compliance is an expression of respect for others.
