**OUR FOOD PANTRY IS SERVING OUR NEIGHBORS THANKS TO YOU!** We always need 1-2lb bags of rice or beans, peanut butter, grape jelly, canned fruit, vegetables, meat, tuna, and soups; spaghetti, cereals, mac and cheese. Leave Food Pantry donations in the Vestibule of the Cathedral or place donations directly in the back of Fr. Jack's car (blue Subaru wagon B11GLY) at the Chapel.

**COVID-19 MEASURES: No one at elevated risk or feeling unwell should attend. No one who cannot comply with these guidelines should attend. Worship via our live-stream Liturgy at 9am.**

All worshippers must wear **masks** inside the building. **Pews are marked** for social distance. Those who live together may sit together. Place your **sacrificial offering** in the basket provided at the entrance. Ushers will not take up a collection. Approach for Holy Communion in a **single line**, following distance markers on the floor. **Take a Green Liturgy** book for your personal use, bring it home, and use it weekly. Once used, books may not be returned. Anything left in pews must be discarded. **Confessions** are heard at the iconostasis. The confessionals are not in use. Approach the iconostasis no later than 20 minutes before start of service for confession. Father is masked to distribute Holy Communion or to hear confessions, limits contact with anything the faithful might touch during the Liturgy, sanitizes before touching the Holy Gifts, and does not drink from the Chalice. The Cathedral and Chapel are completely disinfected each week before Sunday Divine Liturgy. **Please do not congregate in the vestibules** upon entering or leaving. Enjoy each other's company outside.

**SATURDAY, AUGUST 15: DORMITION OF THE THEOTOKOS:** The Divine Liturgy will be served at 9am (Cathedral and live stream). It is customary for the faithful to bring herbs and flowers to be blessed at the Liturgy. **You may bring your own bouquets or plants for the blessing.** We cannot provide items for general distribution under the current COVID restrictions.

**MATINS, the official morning prayer of the Church,** has been offered at the Cathedral before the 9am Liturgy on Sundays since the COVID outbreak began. Vespers, Matins and Liturgy should be served in every parish every Sunday, but especially in the Cathedral Church. Father's responsibilities in Flanders preclude Great Vespers on Saturday evenings, but you are welcome to come earlier on Sundays and accustom yourself to Matins. Booklets are available but all should certainly be able to make the simpler responses: Lord have mercy, Amen, etc. As the Church's official public worship, Matins takes precedence over any private devotion. **Father is happy to interrupt Matins to hear confessions.** Simply follow the directions found on the confessionals (which are no longer in use) and wait until Father notices you. Confessions are made at the iconostasis.
