You may also drop your intentions in the collection or mail them to the parish office. **The Vična Lampa** burns constantly to indicate the presence of God in His Church. THE FILIPOVKA FAST in preparation for Christmas began on November 15 and runs to Christmas Eve. If you do not yet observe meatless Fridays, this is a good time to start. If you already do, consider adding Wednesdays and even Mondays as fast days. Read your way through the prophecies of Isaiah over these 40 days. Bishop especially asks your prayers and fasting for vocations to the priesthood.
