**TUESDAY, JULY 20: FEAST OF THE HOLY PROPHET ELIAS:** Vehicles will be blessed after the 9am Divine Liturgy and again on Sunday, July 25 after each Divine Liturgy. Schedules and privacy make it impossible to hear confessions before the Liturgy at the Chapel. Confessions can also be heard by appointment. Simply call the parish office. The confessionals are not in use.
